## BARBADOS SQUASH RACKETS ASSOCIATION RULES OF THE BARBADOS SQUASH OPEN - 2009

- 1. The Rules of Squash as laid down by the World Squash Federation and as amended May 1st, 2001 shall apply to this tournament.
- 2. The BSRA Code of Conduct dated February 7, 2005 shall be upheld during the tournament. Inappropriate behaviour **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**, and penalties (as stipulated in Rule 17 of the WSF Rules of Squash) will be applied where necessary.
- 3. <u>Eligibility</u>: This tournament is open to all squash players, whether resident in Barbados or not.
- 4. The Dunlop Black Double Yellow Dot Ball shall be the official ball of the tournament.

### 5. All entries close on Thursday June 18, 2009 at 5:00 p.m.

- 6. Completed entry forms accompanied by the entrance fee should be submitted in a sealed envelope addressed to the BSRA Tournament Committee, c/o the Barbados Squash Club, Marine Gardens, Hastings, Christ Church or c/o Pleasant Place Squash Club, Dayrells Road, Christ Church. Entries which are not submitted in the manner MAY NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE DRAW. ALL players must pay the required entrance fee prior to their first match, and may fax their completed entry forms to Craig Archer at (246) 420-4825, or e-mail same to carcher@caribsurf.com
- 7. All matches will be played on a knockout basis and will be 3 best of 5 games with PAR 11 scoring.
- 8. Players will be expected to referee the match following their own. If for any reason the players cannot do so, they are responsible for finding a competent referee to act on their behalf.
- 9. Players are expected to wear proper squash attire (i.e. non-marking shoes and appropriate clothing in accordance with the Rules of Squash). The use of <u>safety goggles</u> is particularly encouraged, and all junior (i.e. under-19) players must wear them while playing in this competition.
- 10. The draw will be made after the close of acceptance of entries and will be posted together with the times of matches on the notice board of the Barbados Squash Club on Saturday June 20, 2009. Players should check for their own match times themselves at the Barbados Squash Club [Telephone: (246) 427-7913]. The BSRA is not responsible for advising players of the times of their matches and will be under no obligation to change times of matches to accommodate players once the draw is published. Overseas players should make themselves available to play at the Barbados Squash Club by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
- 11. This tournament is under the control of the BSRA's Tournament Committee (TC) and that committee shall deal with all disputes. All queries / complaints shall be made to Tournament Committee Convener Tony Mackenzie (246) 243-1019 [cell] or Tournament Director Craig Archer [(246) 231-6332 [cell].
- 12. Players who enter this tournament do so entirely at their own risk and the Barbados Squash Rackets Association (BSRA) and/or the Barbados Squash Club (BSC) will not accept responsibility for any injury or disability arising from participation in the tournament.
